In this second year of the CLOSURE conference, we are inviting academics and practitioners to present their insights, research findings, experience on child, adolescent, adult and gerontological trauma. We are bringing experts from the fields of Anthroposophy as well as those from outside of Anthroposophy to present their own work and guide us for future endeavours in the field.

The conference is a wonderful opportunity for students and teachers of psychology and psychiatry, practitioners, mental health activists and media persons to engage with issues, ideas and challenges dealing with trauma and its closure.

We have gathered together some of the best experts, both academic and professional, to give us insights and expertise and share their experience and knowledge with us. We continue with our exploration of the Indian scenario in this conference too. Therefore, in addition to paper presentations on varied perspectives of 'Anthroposophy' towards 'Trauma', we are also inviting mainstream mental health expert presentations on

- 1. DSM 5 in Indian settings
- 2. Social Research on Transgenerational Trauma in India
- 3. Neurobiology of Trauma.

One can choose to attend the conference either as Research Presenters or Non-Presenters.

Paper Presentations category-

We are inviting research papers focusing mainly on empirical studies and/or meta studies related to the following three topics -

- 1. Childhood and adolescent trauma
- 2. Trauma in adulthood
- 3. Gerontological trauma

One has to be learning, teaching, practising in the Anthroposophic fields of Psychotherapy, Medicine, Nursing, External Therapy, Biography Work, Eurythmy, Body-Dynamic therapy, Curative Education or Waldorf Education to present a research paper on the themes provided above.

Instructions on writing style

- 1. Word length 3000 words (including references)
- 2. References APA style
- 3. Font Times New Roman, 12

The interested research participants are expected to send

- 1. A brief note about themselves not extending 60 words.
- 2. An abstract of the paper not extending 300 words.
- 3. Length of final paper not exceeding 3000 words inclusive of references.

One can register under the Presenter category for a slot to present his/ her abstract during the conference. The final paper will be published only if submitted on or before the 30th of June 2022.

Non-Presenter category -

All students and professionals can participate in the conference without presenting a paper. We are eager to have everyone interested in Mental Health participate in the event.
